Juan Kiti

International artist with multiple talents

None better but Juan Kiti deserves the name of artist, in the absolute sense of the word : creator of art. An art with multiple facets. He also wants his art to contribute to relieve the alas ! so frequent sufferings at the surface of our planet. He is not a megalomaniac of course, but knows very well that each contribution in this field is inevitably limited. But anyone can help, within the limits of its possibilities, to improve somewhat part of life in the world. Juan Kiti has already worked in this direction thanks to the success of Art Gala 92 for the benefit of « Doctors without Borders », Art-Rycke 93 in collaboration with Lord Yehudi Menuhin, and Art Gala 94 for the benefit of the Queen Fabiola Villages n°1 et n°2. At present, he is working on a large project that will allow, thanks to his artistic creation, to help part of those who need it most : the sick and maltreated children. [...]
